What services does the Bursar's Office provide?



- Generates balance due notifications for your student account, which includes charges for tuition, fees, housing, meal plan, etc.
- Processes student account payments
- Promotes student financial wellness and literacy through the iGrad platform and initiatives throughout the academic year

TUpay



- View your current balance and payment due date
- Access real-time view of your student account
- Make payment by electronic check or credit card
- Check refund status and sign-up for direct deposit
- Create an Authorized Payer (parent, etc.)
 - An Authorized Payer is someone that a student grants access to TUpay on his/her behalf. They have the same TUpay functions as students.

Paying Your Tuition and Fees



- Fall balance due notifications are issued starting the 3rd week of July to student's Temple email address and Authorized Payer's email addresses.
- Students must be registered to be charged
- Newly registered students (after the 3rd week of July) will receive balance due notifications on the Monday following registration
- Due date is in September after Labor day.

Ways To Pay



- Online (TUpay) (electronic check and credit card)
- Payments by mail (check only)
- Payments in-Person (cash, check or money order)
- PA 529 College Savings Programs- *If you participate in either the Guaranteed Savings Plan or Investment Plan programs, you must first contact the program to request that a payment be issued to Temple University.*
- International payments- *Flywire-Students can make international payments with real-time currency conversion. This service offers 24-hour support in multiple languages.*

Temple Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)



- TIPP is an interest-free pre-payment plan administered on behalf of the University by Nelnet, Inc.
- The plan allows Temple students to make up to ten regularly scheduled monthly payments starting in May towards their future charges (five payments for fall and five payments for spring).
- Students can finance all or a portion of their charges by paying a \$80 application fee.
- Payments can be made directly to Nelnet, Inc. by pre-authorized debit or credit card.
- Credit card payments are subject to a convenience fee of 2.75%. <https://online.campuscommerce.com/signin/4NPQF>

Deferred Payment Plan



- For the fall and spring semesters, students that do not pay the total account balance will be automatically enrolled in the University's Deferred Payment Plan.
- The Deferred Payment Plan provides additional time to pay your balance.
- Students will be assessed a \$50 non-refundable payment plan fee each semester if the total account balance is not paid by the semester due date. Students do not have to sign up for this payment plan.
- If students are automatically enrolled in the Deferred Payment Plan for fall and spring, the annual fee is \$100.

Signing Up An Authorized Payer



- Creating an Authorized Payer is critical for the student to do
- An Authorized Payer is someone such as a parent that a student grants access to view his/her account in TUpay.
- An Authorized Payer has access to the same financial information in TUpay as the student including making online payments.
- An Authorized Payer receives an e-mail notification each time a student balance due email is sent.

Signing Up for Direct Deposit



- Signing up for direct deposit is the other absolutely critical function students must perform in TUpay along with creating Authorized Payers.
- Refunds available sooner & safely deposited directly into your bank account
- No waiting for checks via snail mail
- Students log into TUportal, select Cost & Aid, select TUpay and select Manage My Refunds to setup direct deposit.






